Appendix: Objectives of the Investment-linked funds

The investment-linked funds below are either managed by the investment team of Prudential Assurance Malaysia Berhad, Eastspring Investments Berhad, Eastspring Al-Wara' Investments Berhad or any other third-party fund managers. Please refer to the Product Disclosure Sheet for the list of funds that is applicable to the product. Investment Objective(s)

PRULink Equity Income Fund (PI) (Equity fund):

This fund aims to maximise returns over medium to long term. This is achieved by investing in a diversified portfolio of high quality shares and dividend yielding stocks which have or can potentially have attractive dividend yields.

PRULink Equity Focus Fund (FF) (Equity fund):

This fund aims to maximise returns over medium to long term. This is achieved by investing into approximately 30 quality Malaysian companies listed in Bursa Malaysia that are expected to provide medium to long-term capital appreciation and income potential.

PRULink Managed Fund II (PM2) (Managed fund):
